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**Health Attestation:**

*The undersigned certificate certifies that the above aquatic animals or products satisfy the following:*

- *The requirements of the Sierra Leone Fish and fishery Products Regulations, 2007; the Food and Feed Safety Act, 2017; and International/ EU Regulations.*
- *The Competent Authority carried out official control of the above live aquatic animals and aquatic products on its capture, handling, landing, packaging, and are ensured to satisfy the conditions of the Regulations mentioned above.*
- *Any clinical signs of diseases listed in the Fisheries and Aquaculture Act, 2011 and the Public Health Act, 1960, of the Republic of Sierra Leone should not be observed*
- *The above live aquatic animals or aquatic products should not be intended for destruction or slaughter for eradication of disease in exporting countries*
- *The above live aquatic animals or aquatic products should not be in contact with other live aquatic animals, aquatic animal products, eggs or gametes of a lower health and water contaminated with aquatic animal pathogens*
- *Any pathogenic agent causes the disease described below should not be detected from laboratory tests based on the Manual of Diagnostic Tests for Aquatic Animals of OIE or the diagnostic methods approved by the diagnostic methods of the Sierra Leone Standards Bureau*

**Live aquatic animals:**

*For finfish: Epizootic haematopoietic necrosis, Spring viraemia of carp, Viral haemorrhagic septicaemia, infectious salmon anaemia, Red sea bream iridoviral disease, Koi herpesvirus, Epizootic ulcerative syndrome, Gyrodactylosis.*

*For molluscs: infections with Bonamia ostreae, Bonamia exitiosa, Marteilia refringens, Perkinsus marinus, Xenohaliotis californensis, Abalone herpesvirus, and White spot disease*

*For crustaceans: Crayfish plague, Infectious hypodermal and haematopoietic necrosis virus with yellow head virus genotype-1, White spot disease, Taura syndrome, Infectious myonecrosis, White tail disease*

**For frozen and chilled aquatic animal products (shrimps, oyster and abalone)**

*Shrimps (except for heated or peeled or beheaded): Infectious hypodermal and haematopoietic necrosis virus. Infection with yellow head virus genotype-1, White spot disease, Taura syndrome, Infectious myonecrosis, White tail disease*

*Oyster (except of heated or cooked) : infections with Marteilia refringens. Bonamia ostreae, Bonamia exitiosa, Perkinsus marinus, White spot disease*

*Abalone (except of heated or cooked): Infection with abalone herpesvirus, Xenohaliotis californensis*
